Our team gets to know each patient's daily activities and hobbies to help determine the best vision solution for his or her lifestyle.

Vision correction procedures typically take only ten minutes per eye, and most patients recognize a significant improvement in vision less than 24-hours after the procedure.

Dr. Schumer and Dr. Shah have strong relationships with optometrists in the area who often refer patients to ReVision for cataract, LASIK and cornea procedures. After surgery at ReVision, patients return to their own optometrists for follow-up care.

ReVision is one of the few practices in the U.S. to use heads-up technology while performing surgical procedures. During surgery, the surgeons look forward at a large 3D monitor versus looking down through a microscope.

ReVision developed a program called "ReVision Gives Back" to support local non-profit organizations in Columbus and Mansfield.
